



General Campground Information

SEASON DATES

- May 1 to October 1

Please call 715.623.3633 extension-154/131 for availability if camping prior to May 1 or after October 1

CHECK-OUT and RE-REGISTRATION

- Check-Out time is 1:00 pm on the following day of the last paid night.
- Campers must re-register by 4:00pm the day prior to their last day if they wish to stay additional nights. Please call our office to confirm availability (715.623.3633 extension-131/154)

FEES

- Padded RV Sites 1-12 (accommodates RV's up to 45' in length): \$20.00 per night
 - Sites include water, electricity (30 amps), and sewer hook-up
- Smaller Padded RV Site 13: \$10.00 per night
 - Site 13 has water and sewer hook-up, but **no** electric
- Tent sites 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20: \$10.00 per night (sites 14-30) and have electric.
- Overflow RV Sites: \$10.00 per night (sites 32-38) and do not have hook-ups

RESERVATIONS

Reservations will be accepted for all sites beginning one year out from the requested registration date. Full payment is required within 5 business days.

FIRST-COME, FIRST-SERVED SITES

To claim first-come, first-served sites (unreserved) campers must place an appropriate camping unit on the site (i.e. camper, motor home or erected camping tent). Hunting blinds, children's play tents, boats, coolers, chairs, tents in bags, etc. are not appropriate.

RESTROOMS, SHOWERS and Wi-Fi

- All sites have access to restrooms and showers.
- **Restroom and Wi-Fi Access Code:** Please contact our office for the restroom and WIFI access code during office hours: Monday-Thursday, 8:30am – 4:30pm; Fridays, 8:30am – 12:00pm (715.623.3633 extension-154 or 131). If you need the access code after hours please contact the non-emergency police (715.627.6411). If you reserve on-line you will receive an e-mail with the codes located at the bottom of your receipt.

GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS

- Pets are allowed. Pet waste must be picked up and disposed of in a proper manner by owner. Pets must be on a leash at all times. Pets must not become a nuisance to other campers.
- Campfires are only allowed in designated fire pits. Grills or portable fire pits may also be used.
- Wood that has been kiln dried or debarked is permitted in the campground.
- Quiet time is 10:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.
- Campsite fees are nonrefundable unless requested 2 weeks prior to reservation date. Qualifying refunds will have a 25% administrative processing fee assessed.

DUMP STATION USE (non-campers)

- Use of the dump station for non-campers is \$10.00 per use.
- Please complete the envelope located at the dump station and place in the drop-box with payment.
